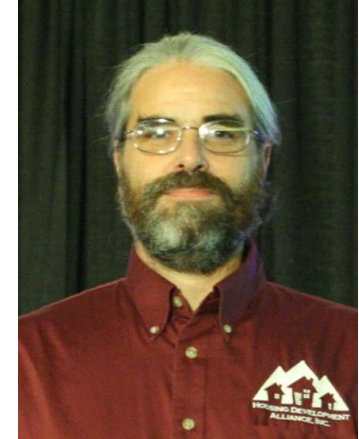

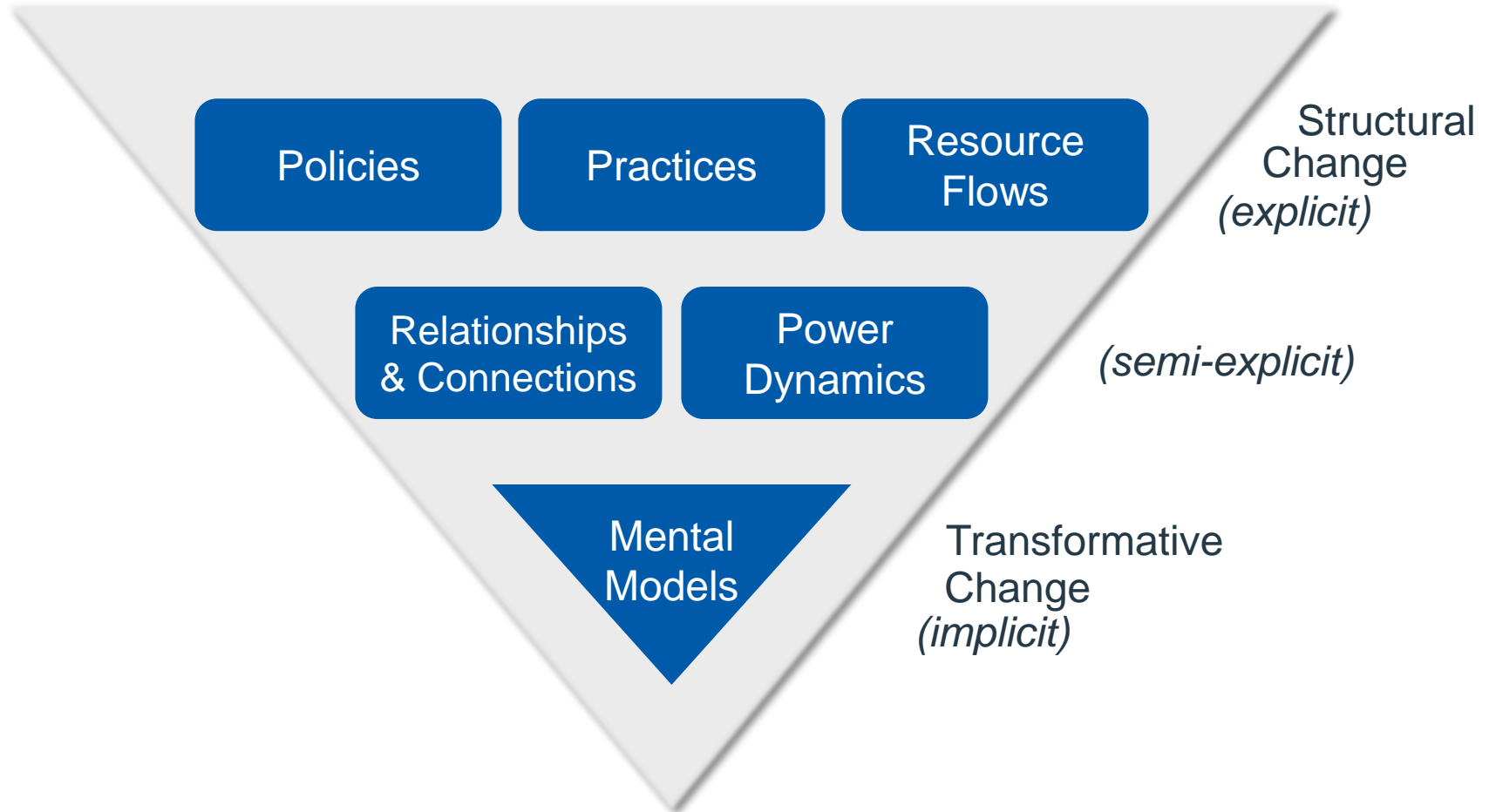

holding a problem in place**

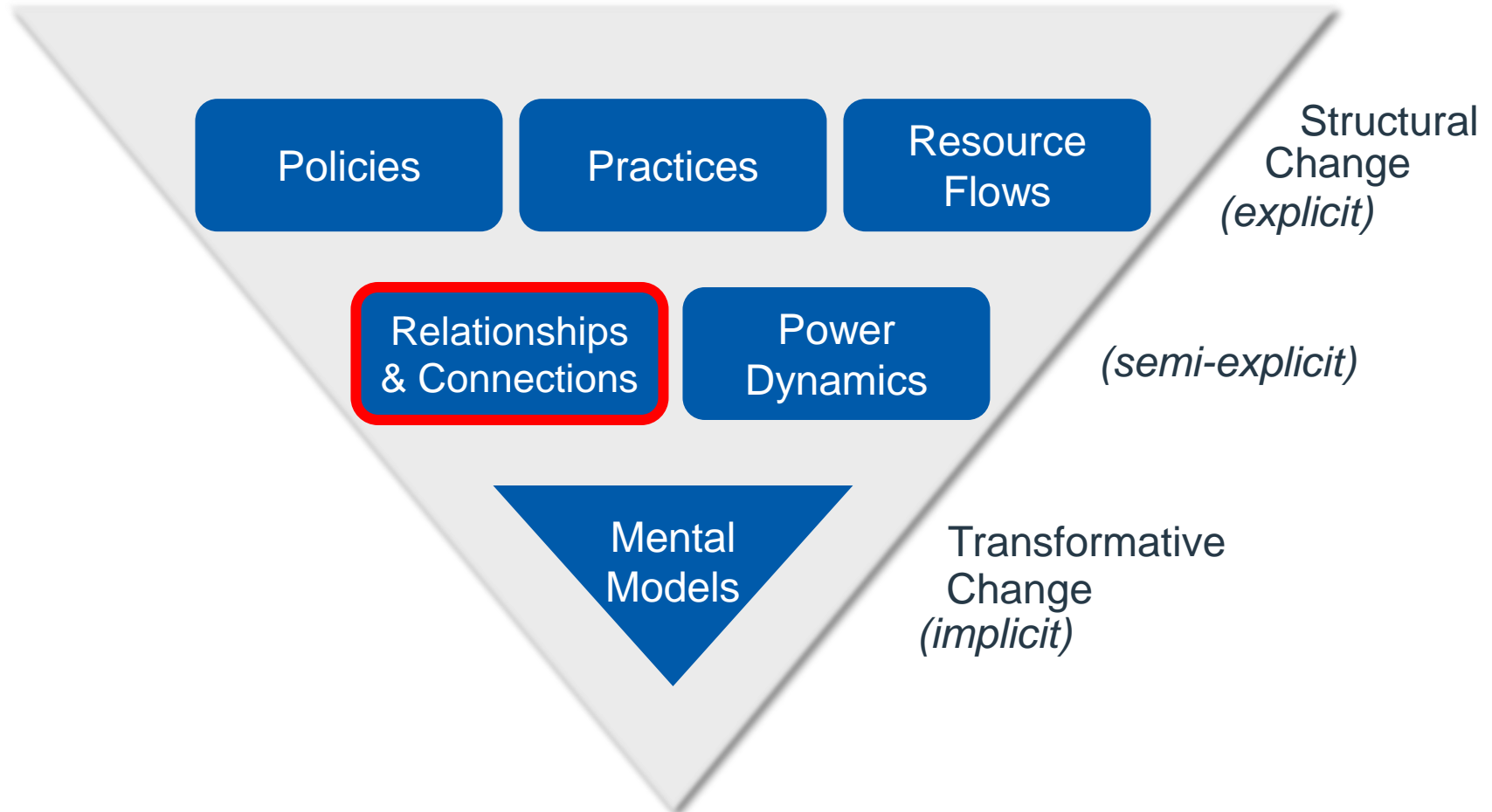
Shifting the Conditions That Hold the Problem In Place

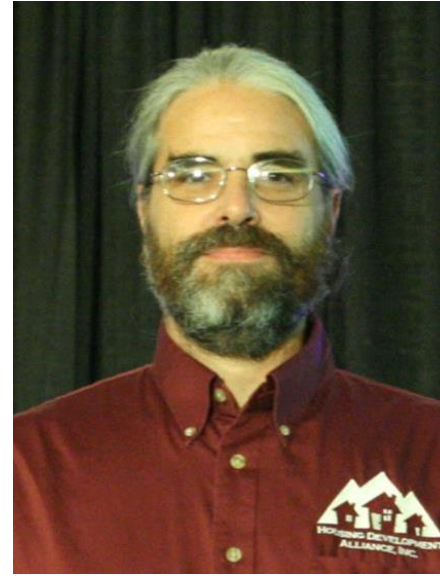

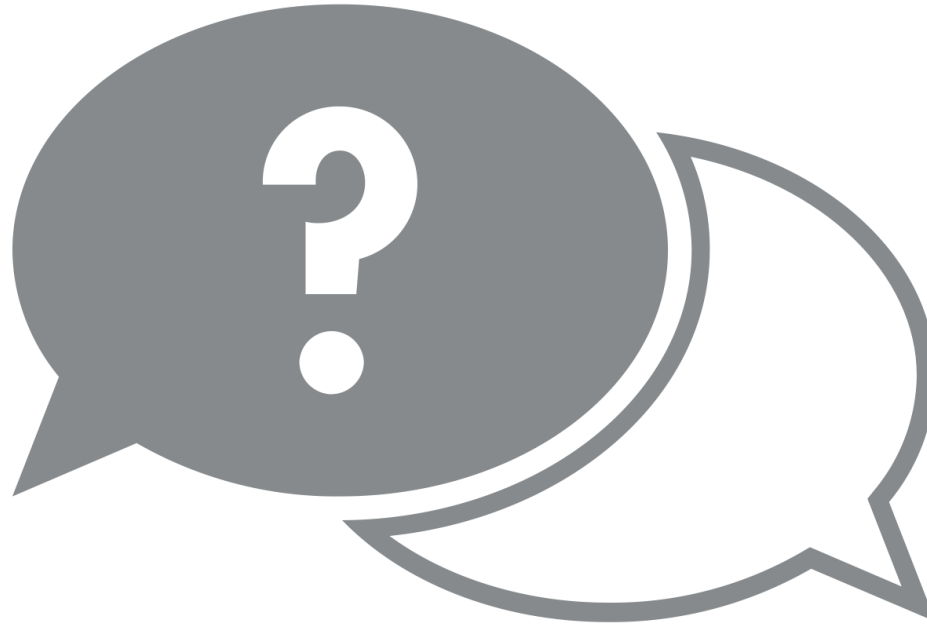
